3	Risk of fall from trees	Minimise tree climbing and always supervise	1		Kids like to climb trees – we should not stop them. Bat make sure they are safe.
3	Risk of drowning	Monitor paddling in local streams	1		If the water is likely to be deeper than their ankles, have BA's available and a throw line.
2	Risk from Wildlife	Leave wildlife alone – stay away from Mink/ Badgers etc..	1		
3	Risk from Farm animals	Stay back from farm animals. If in doubt, do not enter their field	1		If contact is made – make sure sanitiser is available and that ticks are removed properly. Be aware of sheep scab.
